## **Our Purpose**

*The Sheonoroil Foundation supports research, writing and distribution of information and interventions which focus on all forms of violence and the promotion of peace in public schools (primary to grade 12).*

## **Our History**

*The Sheonoroil Foundation has existed since the late 1990s. Following upon years of school research initiated by the Nova Scotia Teachers Union (NSTU), data returned indicated that violence in Nova Scotia public schools required immediate attention. A provincial Anti-Violence Symposium was organized in 1997 and the following year a substantial Anti-Violence Resource Library Publication was sent to all provincial public schools, community college campuses and school boards. In 1999 the Sheonoroil Foundation was launched, with the first funding grants awarded in the school year 2000-2001.*

## **Our Mandate**

*Sheonoroil will offer financial resources to any active or retired member of the Nova Scotia Teachers Union, to any group of active or retired NSTU members, or to any group of public school students working in cooperation with a teacher. Funding is based on an application review process.*

*Funding grants shall be awarded for anti-violence programs and projects that have a direct and immediate impact on students, teachers, staff, administration and the community within public schools.*
